With the addition of these two officers and a third in the near future, we cannot only provide increased police patrols of our residential and business areas but also provide better enforcement of our ordinances including parking permits. You should notice an improvement in the near future.

CODE COMPLIANCE MONTHLY REPORT

Follow-up from April: seven properties that were issued high grass notices were found to be in compliant.

One high grass notice was issued in May and has since complied.

Bate's Trucking recently suspended bulk trash pickup due to the COVID-19 health emergency. Five properties set out bulk trash and have since pulled it in. Bulk trash pickup is scheduled to resume June 17.

Code Enforcement has also been working to identify residences placing their recyclables curbside in plastic bags. Plastic bags inhibit the processing of the recyclables and are prohibited. Town Ordinance O-4-2019 prohibits plastic bags as part of recycling whether inside or outside the recycling bin and provides for a \$50 fine for violation of the ordinance. Warnings are being issued for violations now.

BULK TRASH RESUMES JUNE 17TH

Bulk services were suspended since April 1st due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Bates Trucking is happy to announce that we will **resume bulk services on June 17th.**



Bulky Trash Collection is provided by appointment only. To schedule an appointment call 301-773-2069; Thursdays 9am - Tuesdays 2pm to get on the bulk trash list that Wednesday's service. Appointments can also be scheduled online by filling out the [Bates Request Form](#) and selecting the Bulk Trash option under 'Service Type'.

Only 3 bulk items are permitted per week. Clothing, books, shoes, household items (i.e. pots, pan, utensils, etc.) should be placed into a box or bag (3 boxes-one item, 5 bags-one item).
